### RETURN ENTRY TO / ANFON FFURFLEN AT: Welsh Athletics, WELSH ELIGIBILITY/CYMWYSTERAU CYMRU

All competitors must have at least one of the following qualifications:

- a Birth: the athlete having been born in Wales
- b Parentage: one or both parents born in Wales
- c Residence: a minimum of 2 years' continuous residence in Wales immediately prior to the event to be competed in
- d Retention: athletes who have competed for Wales at full Senior International level under the residence qualification retain their Welsh eligibility, regardless of residence, until such time as they compete for another country (but not another area)

#### WELSH REGISTRATION SCHEME

All athletes who wish to enter the Welsh Championships **MUST** be registered with the Welsh Athletics before entering. Members of Welsh clubs should obtain registration forms from their clubs. Athletes who are members of clubs outside Wales can obtain their forms from the Welsh Athletics Office. Forms not including Registration Numbers will be returned and not accepted.

**\*\* NB\*\*** Athletes are reminded that Portable Music Systems (eg Walkmans) and Mobile Phones are not permitted within the Competition Area.

Athletes are reminded that they **MUST** report at least **one and a half hours** before their first event

**NB: Please allow plenty of time for your journey, as failure to register at least one and a half hours before, may result in you NOT being allowed to compete**
